Nonviolent Peaceforce (NP) is a dynamic international, non-governmental organization which works to reduce violence and protect civilians in situations of violent conflict and its aftermath, mostly through the deployment on the ground of multinational teams of civilians.

In South Sudan, NP has 13 field teams providing thematically focused protection programming in child protection, gender based violence protection and prevention, displacement (IDPs, inter-communal violence reduction and conflict early warning/early response). This young country programme is growing rapidly responding to the dynamic, high needs environment in South Sudan.

This new position, reporting to the Program Development Manager, has been created to meet NP's growing communications needs, Support the Programme Development Team and NPSS Country Programme as a whole on public communications and outreach, to improve external visibility and gain traction from key partners, especially international missions and relevant donor agencies including developing key messages for media contacts and use of social media.
